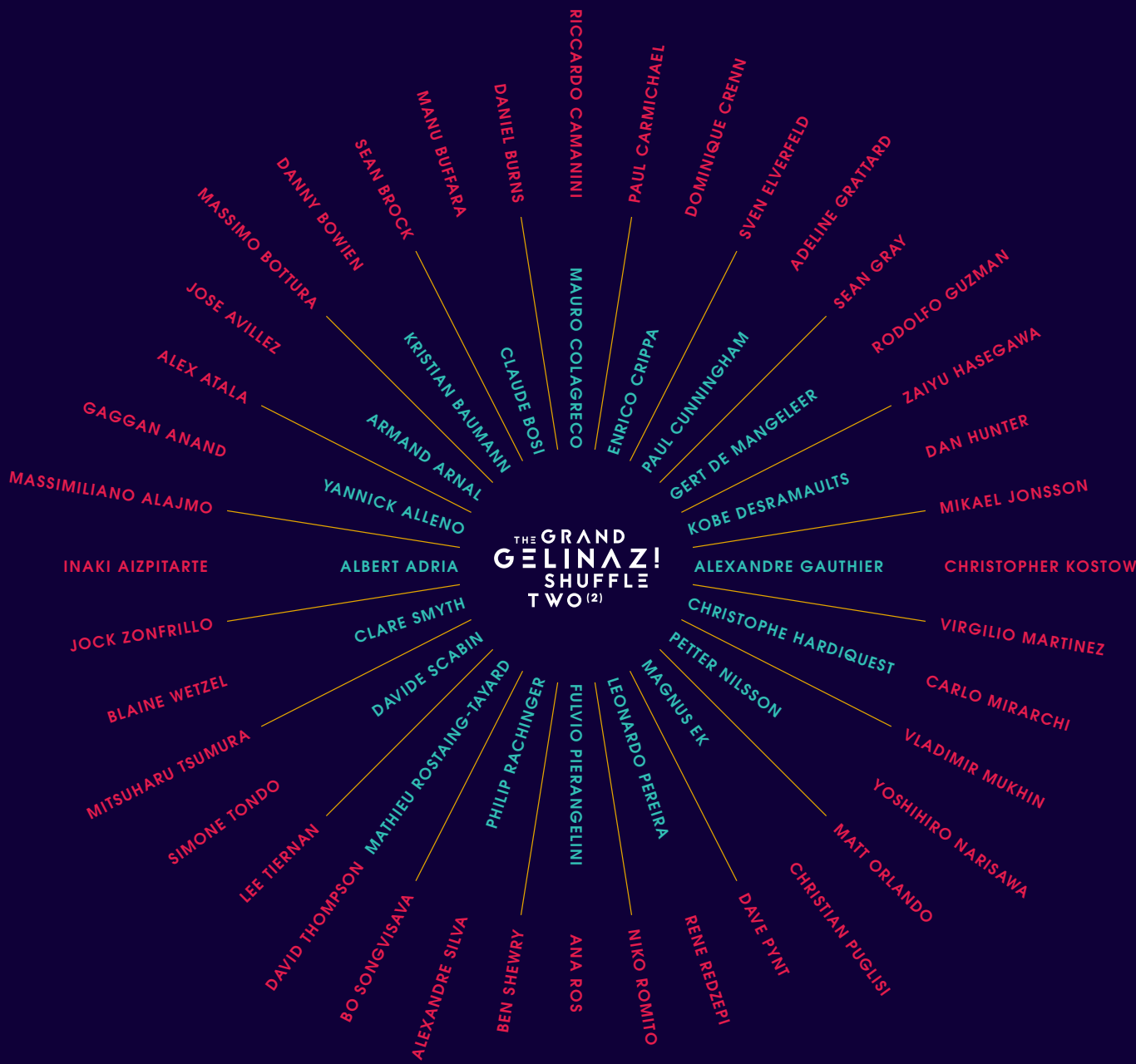


THE GRAND GELINAZI! SHUFFLE TWO (2)
